UPDATE TO WORSHIPS SAFE PROTOCOLS

The Archdiocese of Toronto has recently updated the current WorshipSafe practices based on the announcement by the Province of Ontario on Friday, October 22.

We are pleased to advise that we have **increased seating capacity** in the Cathedral, as we are now permitted to offer seating in every second row (instead of every third row). This will allow for more people to attend Mass every weekend. Registration will still be required for Sunday Masses with more spots now available. We will still maintain the 6 feet distance within each pew, as well as continue wearing masks.

Based on advice from health & safety experts, parishes can now resume congregational singing. The choirs of St Michael's Choir School, as well as our cantors, will lead us in song. Our hymnals have also been placed back in the pews for you to join in. Copies of the music for each Mass can be found by the entrance the church.
