UPDATE ON COVID-19 RESTRICTIONS

Thank you for your ongoing patience and co-operation over the past two years in adapting to the Covid-19 reality and the many associated restrictions.

We are pleased to share that, as of **March 1, 2022**, we are able to offer seating at full capacity with no physical distancing restrictions. *Please note that masks will still be required indoors.*

As of next weekend, registration will no longer be required for Sunday Masses.

ASH WEDNESDAY

This year, **Ash Wednesday** will be on **March 2** and marks the beginning of **Lent**.

It is a day of **Fasting and Abstinence**. *Fasting* (one full meal and two smaller meals) applies to those 18-59 years. This does not apply to those who are pregnant, sick or elderly. *Abstinence* from meat applies to those 14 and older.

Ashes will be distributed at all Masses on Wednesday, March 2 in the Cathedral. The choirs of St. Michael's Choir School will be singing at the 12:10 PM and the 5:30 PM Masses that day. Seating is first come, first seated.

STATIONS OF THE CROSS FRIDAYS OF LENT

Every **Friday evening at 6:15 PM** during the season of Lent, the Cathedral will follow the Stations of the Cross. This devotion helps us to contemplate the passion and crucifixion of Our Lord, and helps our hearts grow more penitent as we prepare for the coming of Easter. Join us beginning **Friday, March 4**th after the 5:30 PM Mass, and all Friday evenings during Lent.
