PENTECOST SUNDAY

This weekend we celebrate the Solemnity of Pentecost, which represents the completion of the Easter season, and the descent of the Holy Spirit upon Christ's disciples. Throughout these 50 days of Easter, we have celebrated the resurrection of Christ, his ascension to God the Father in heaven, and the ongoing ministry of the Church guided by the Holy Spirit. If you look up towards the ceiling above the altar in this Cathedral, there is a ring of lights with a dove in the centre, representing the Holy Spirit descending upon the Church.

Although we now enter Ordinary Time in the liturgical calendar, the next two Sundays are still observed as Solemnities. Next Sunday, we will reflect on the mystery of the Triune God, as we observe the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity. In two weeks, we will celebrate Corpus Christi, the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ.

Congratulations to those who are receiving the gift of the Holy Spirit, the sacrament of Confirmation, at the noon Mass this Pentecost Sunday!
