SYNODAL WORKING DOCUMENT RELEASED

The General Secretariat of the Synod recently rereleased the *Instrumentum Laboris* for the first session of the 16th Ordinary General Assembly of the Synod of Bishops. The working document, which is derived from the material collected during the phase of listening to the People of God, is to be seen as a tool for discernment.
