# CONFERRAL OF THE PALLIUM UPON ARCHBISHOP LEO ON THE FEAST OF ST. MICHAEL & THE ARCHANGELS

On Friday, September 29, 2023, on the feast day of our patron, St. Michael, and the Archangels, there will be a special celebration at our 5:30 PM Mass when the Apostolic Nuncio to Canada, the Most Rev. Ivan Jurkovič, will confer the pallium on our archbishop, a symbol of his role as Metropolitan Archbishop of Toronto and shepherd to the faithful. Archbishop Francis Leo will celebrate Mass, accompanied by the music of the St. Michael's Choir School Senior Choir. Seating will be first come, first seated. A reception will follow the Mass.

We will celebrate the Feast of St. Michael and the Archangels at all of our regular Masses that day, including **7:30 AM** and **12:10 PM**, with music from St. Michael's Choir School at our 12:10 PM Mass.


