LENT

Lent grew out of the penitent order in the Early Church, where people who had committed grave sins would undergo a period of public fasting and penance to become reconciled with the Church. Over time, this developed into a universal practice for all the faithful to prepare for the celebration of the Lord's paschal mystery at Easter.

As we observe Lent, let us reflect on how we can change the things in our lives that get in the way of our relationship with God.

In Lent, the Roman Missal permits the organ to be played only to support the singing, except on the Fourth Sunday of Lent (Laetare), solemnities, and feasts. The liturgies of Lent take on a different character without instrumental embellishment, calling Christians to prayer, not through music, but in silence.
