#### **CONSECRATION TO THE BLESSED** VIRGIN MARY ON THE SOLEMNITY OF THE ANNUNCIATION OF THE LORD

This year, the Solemnity of the Annunciation of the Lord is transferred to April 8, and His Grace Archbishop Leo invites all to join him in the archdiocesan consecration to the Blessed Virgin Mary on this feast. This initiative comes at the request of Pope Francis, who has invited Catholics to annually renew an act of consecration to the Immaculate Heart of Mary at the occasion of the Solemnity of the Annunciation of the Lord.

The Archdiocese of Toronto has provided resources to assist us, including a guide for a Marian Triduum to prepare ourselves, the Ritual of Consecration, and resources for families and parishes.
