A short walking procession will take place in the streets surrounding the Cathedral followed by Solemn Benediction. Time for fellowship will take place after the procession in the Cathedral courtyard.

To accommodate the procession around the block, Bond Street will be closed from Shuter to Dundas from approximately **12:00 PM to 3:00 PM**. As a result, street parking and the school playground/parking lot will be inaccessible during this time. Please plan on taking public transit or parking at an alternate location on this day. We apologize for the inconvenience.

We look forward to having you join us for the Cathedral's inaugural Corpus Christi Procession and hope to make this an annual tradition for years to come.

**PERMANENT DIACONATE
ORDINATIONS**

In 1964, the Second Vatican Council revived the Permanent Diaconate. The Council states: "at a lower level of the hierarchy are to be found deacons, who receive the imposition of hands 'not for the priesthood but for the ministry.'" For, strengthened by sacramental grace, they are dedicated to the people of God, in communion with the bishop and his presbyterate, in the service of the liturgy, of the word and of charity.
