PENTECOST SUNDAY

This weekend we celebrate the Solemnity of Pentecost, which represents the completion of the Easter season, and the descent of the Holy Spirit upon Christ's disciples. CORPUS CHRISTI MASS & PROCESSION

All are welcome to join the **Most Reverend Francis Leo, Archbishop of Toronto**, for a Corpus Christi Procession here on **Sunday, June 2, 2024** following the **Noon Mass**. A short walking procession will take place in the streets surrounding the Cathedral followed by Solemn Benediction. Time for fellowship will take place after the procession in the Cathedral courtyard.

To accommodate the procession around the block, Bond Street will be closed from Shuter to Dundas from approximately **12:00 PM to 3:00 PM**. As a result, street parking and the school playground/parking lot will be inaccessible during this time. Please plan on taking public transit or parking at an alternate location on this day. We apologize for the inconvenience.

We look forward to having you join us for the Cathedral's inaugural Corpus Christi Procession and hope to make this an annual tradition for years to come.

PERMANENT DIACONATE ORDINATIONS

In 1964, the Second Vatican Council revived the Permanent Diaconate. The Council states: "at a lower level of the hierarchy are to be found deacons, who receive the imposition of hands 'not for the priesthood but for the ministry." For, strengthened by sacramental grace, they are dedicated to the people of God, in communion with the bishop and his presbyterate, in the service of the liturgy, of the word and of charity.

On **Saturday, May 25 at 10:00 AM, Bishop Nguyen** will ordain twelve men to the Permanent Diaconate here at St. Michael's Cathedral Basilica. Space will be limited, but all are welcome to join via livestream: https://www.stmichaelscathedral.com/live/.


