"I am writing in anticipation of the Solemnity of Saint Michael the Archangel which we celebrate on September 29th. We have added reason to celebrate the great defender and celestial helper because he is the patron saint of the Archdiocese of Toronto. Last year I invited everyone to join our archdiocesan family in praying the Novena to St. Michael the Archangel in preparation for the feast.
